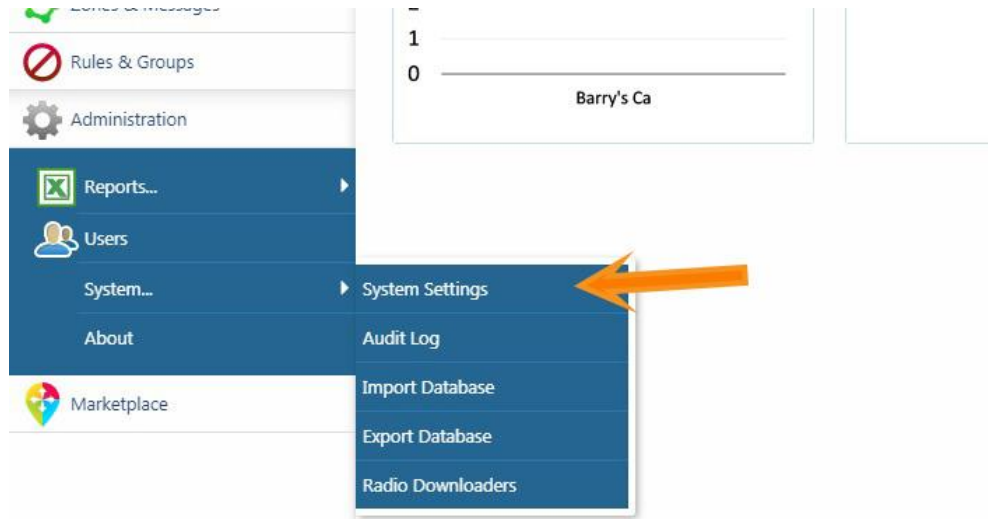

# How to add Ok Alone to myGeotab




Here are the steps to add Ok Alone to your myGeotab account

- 1) Login to myGeotab as an admin user or an account with permissions to install add-ins and create users
- 2) Go to Administration >> System >> System Settings from the main menu



### 3) Make sure “Allow unsigned Add-Ins” is set to On and click Save



#### 4) Click “New Add-In”, paste the following json text, click Ok and then Save

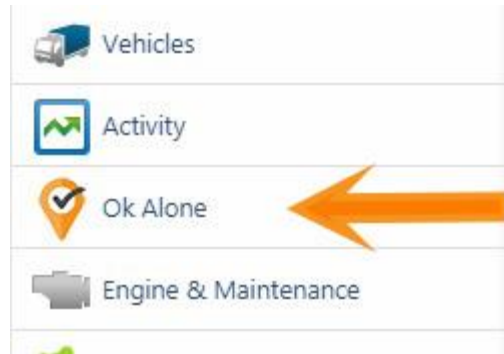


